World Forum Capacity 2,160 seated / 5,000+ reception The World Forum is the city's main convention center. Boasting over 40,000 sqm, it accommodated the successful international UN conference on Afghanistan with 73 delegations in 2009. The combination of a multi-functional auditorium/theater (the country's largest) and various breakout areas makes the World Forum the perfect venue for every type of event. Fokker Terminal Capacity 1,000 seated / 1,000 reception The Fokker Terminal, located at 5 minutes distance from both railway stations is a former aerospace training institute.
